DISCUSSIONS	

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Steve Bahns, Sign-A-Rama, Lebanon, Ohio, was present to discuss the permitting process

Mr. Bahns stated that Otterbein Home has hired him to relocate the existing sign in front of Bethany Hall that is proposed for demolition to the front of the building that will house their Home Health organization. He stated that the project requires the removal of the current sign

relative to the relocation of a sign within the Otterbein campus in Turtlecreek Township.

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from sleeve posts, installing two new sleeve posts cemented in the ground at the new location, changing the graphics on the sign panel faces, and reinstallation of the posts and panel at the new location across the street. He stated that the total project cost is \$691.00. He then stated that upon contacting Warren County, the fees to relocate this sign are as follows: Planning Commission - \$250.00, Building Permit - \$206.00, and Zoning Permit - \$100.00. He stated his concern with the \$691.00 project costing \$556.00 in fees. He requested the Board to help him with a more appropriate fee as well as expedite the process to make this project more reasonable and affordable.

Bob Ware, Regional Planning Commission, explained that the current zoning code only addresses billboard signs. He then explained that this sign relocation is technically considered a revised final site plan that can be handled administratively for approval but the Board of Commissioners cannot waive any permits charged by the Regional Planning Commission.

Dave Gully, County Administrator, suggested that the Board consider the future adoption of some sort of fee cap which stated no fees shall exceed 5% of the project cost.

The Board stated in great detail the need to identify and fix shortcomings such as these in the new zoning code.

Commissioner Young iterated the need to apply common sense in matters such as these.

Upon further discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #10-631) waive 75% of the Building Permit fee and 100% of the Zoning Permit fee for a total cost of \$51.50.

The Board accepted the resignation of Kimm Coyner as Economic Development Director and thanked Ms. Coyner for her public service.

Commissioner Young acknowledged the numerous jobs that have been obtained as well as retained for Warren County due to her efforts.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
