DISCUSSIONS

Chris Brausch, Sanitary Engineer, was present for a work session and discussed the following matters:

- 1. Paul Brothers request for payment plan—The Board agreed to waive ½ of the sanitary sewer tap-in fee and allow payments on their bill for payoff in four years.
- 2. Proposed Hart Road waterline project with the City of Lebanon—County will construction 1700 feet of 8" waterline to serve 11 Lebanon Customers, the estimated project cost is \$155,000 and the City of Lebanon will contribute \$124,900
- 3. Springboro metered interconnection cost sharing—The material cost is \$31,000 and the County will design and install the pit in the spring with Springboro paying half of the cost
- 4. Union Road Water Treatment Plant demolition bids—lowest bid is from Bruce Osborn, Osborn Excavating at a cost of \$18,750
- 5. Harveysburg Road Waterline—OPWC project to improve the roadway and replace 1870 feet of 6" PVC. The project is scheduled for 2010 and Peter Carroll will contribute

approximately \$40,000. The estimated cost of installing a new 8" ductile iron line was \$122,500. Mr. Carroll would like to upsize the line to a 12" to provide future service for build out of his property. Cost of the 12" is estimated at \$148,000. Mr. Carroll is requesting the Board contribute \$22,000 to the project or allow him to utilize PVC pipe at a lower cost. The Board determined to not contribute nor allow the use of PVC pipe.

The Board entered into a work session to discuss budget matters with Tiffany Zindel, Director of OMB.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 10:47 a.m. to discuss union negotiations pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(4) and exited at 11:05 a.m.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
