DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Larry Easterly, Warren County Park Board Director, was present along with Warren County Park Board members, Maggie Hess, Warren County Career Center Superintendent, and teachers from the construction trade classes at the Career Center to discuss the replacement of the concession stand at Warren County Armco Park.

Commissioner Young reviewed the previous conversations with the Park Board about replacing the existing concession stand and utilizing the services of the Career Center Construction Technology Program.

Ben Yoder, Park Board member, stated that there has been decreased usage of the softball fields due to the condition of the current concession stand.

Mr. Easterly produced a rendering of the proposed two story concession stand (attached). He stated that the two story design would provide approximately 2500 sq. ft. of building space and an additional 2000 sq. ft. of deck space, allowing the possibility of renting the space for other functions.

Mr. Yoder stated that the cost for the basic plan would be \$500,500 which would include a warming kitchen. He stated that the addition of a full kitchen would add approximately \$150,000 to that estimate. He then stated it would be more cost effective to add a full kitchen now rather than in the future. He added that the purchase of tables and chairs to furnish the concession stand would add approximately \$11,000.

Mr. Yoder then explained that utilizing the services of the Career Center is estimated to lower the costs to approximately \$425,000.

Steve Williamson, Instructor for the Carpentry Tech Program at the Career Center, along with Mike Wolf, Heavy Equipment Instructor, Deon Gephart, HVAC Instructor and Rick Centers, Electricity Prep Instructor, explained the process and timeline that would need to be followed for each of the building trades for the project in order to follow the seasons and the school schedule.

There was discussion relative to park utilization and how to bring increased revenue into the park.

Commissioner South questioned how much would be needed in addition to the \$425,000 to construct the project with the full kitchen.

Mr. Yoder stated that the estimated contingency would be \$45,000 which includes transportation fees for the students as well as a ten percent (10%) surcharge on the materials that the Career Center uses to offset wear and tear on tools.

Commissioner Young stated that he is inclined to support the project but would like further input on the advantage of having a full kitchen versus the warming kitchen. He further stated that he would like the Park Board to be creative in generating revenue and suggested that they consider selling naming rights to the new concession stand.

Mrs. South stated that she is also inclined to support the project with further input regarding the kitchen.

Mr. Williamson stated that due to the demand for services from the Career Center, the sooner they have approval the better, as they could add this project to their current project list.

Upon further discussion, and since the decision on the kitchen doesn't need to be made until later in the project, the Board stated their agreement to begin the project. They stated their desire to contribute \$200,000 to the project in 2015 in order for the Career Center to begin before winter.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.

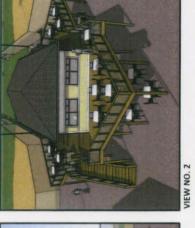

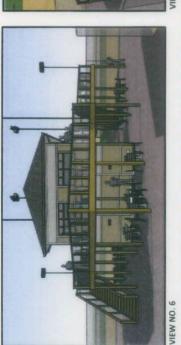




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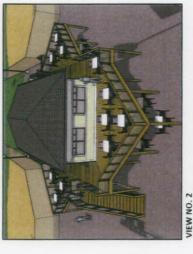


WARREN COUNTY PARK DISTRICT ARMCO PARK

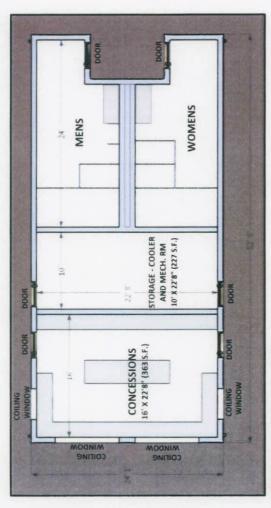


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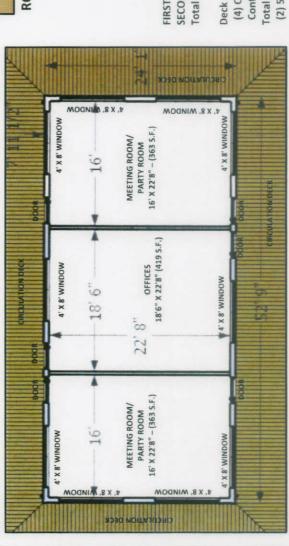








FIRST FLOOR PLAN North
