## DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

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Susan Spencer, Personnel Officer, was present to introduce new hires from the first quarter of 2017.

Aaron Reid, Warren County United Way, was present along with Mitchell Willis, Shared Harvest Food Bank, for the Board to proclaim May 13, 2017, as "The National Letter Carriers Association Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive Day" in Warren County.

On motion, bids were closed at 9:15 a.m. this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May and the following bids were received, opened and read aloud for Sale of Scrap Metal for the Warren County Water and Sewer Department:

\$ 60.00 per ton / Fire Hydrants, Scrap, etc. \$1.75 per pound /Copper \$0.60 per pound/Brass \$0.65 per pound / Water Meter

Chris Brausch, Sanitary Engineer, will review bids for a recommendation at a later date.

Chris Brausch, Sanitary Engineer, was present along with staff for a work session to discuss the following matters:

- 1. Mr. Brausch requested approval of an engineering agreement with Dixon Engineering relative to the inspection and oversight of the tower painting projects relative to technical requirements such as paint thickness, etc. Upon discussion, the Board approved the agreement.
- 2. Amendments to the Rules and Regulations of the Warren County Water and Sewer District—Mr. Brausch reviewed the proposed changes to the regulations including a new section to address backflow prevention, update to capacity charges based upon cost of living and an update to the personnel who are permitted to approve penalty waivers.

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Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution #17-0694) to modify, change, and update various sections of the rules and regulations of the Warren County Water and Sewer Department including the adoptions of new regulations on backflow prevention and cross connection control.

- 3. Draft logo designed by Deerfield Township—Mr. Brausch presented the draft logo that Deerfield Township intends to have painted and pay costs associated relative to the 20 Mile Water Tower. The Board stated their concurrence with the logo.
- 4. Mr. Brausch presented background information relative to the request from President Trump for the identification of burdensome regulations. Mr. Brausch stated his concern relative to the Environmental Protection Agency adopting more stringent regulations which would cause a financial hardship to local governments. Mr. Brausch requested authorization to send a joint letter that includes Butler, Clermont and Green County identifying the regulations. Upon discussion, the Board authorized Mr. Brausch to send the letter.
- 5. Private Lift Station Reimbursement—Mr. Brausch reviewed the decision of the Board in October 2016 relative to no longer maintaining the private lift station located on private property within the Morrow-Roachester Sewer Improvement Project Area. He informed the Board that notices were provided to the property owners and there was recently a failure of one of the pumps. He also stated that he was informed that the lift stations are locked and only Water and Sewer staff have the key. He then presented the request of the property owner for reimbursement due to no notification of the change in policy.

There was discussion relative to the lack of notification to the property owners as well as the stations being locked. The Board then discussed the liability issue relative to the initial decision to no longer service the private lift stations.

Upon discussion, the Board directed Mr. Brausch to notify the property owners of the policy and provide a way for property owners to access the pump stations. They then stated their desire to reimburse the property owners as requested due to the lack of notification.

- 6. SR 73 Interconnect with Western Water—Chris Wojnicz, Deputy Sanitary Engineer, provided background information relative to the interconnection, at our request, to Western Water's system along SR 73. He presented the request to reimburse Western Water for our portion of the construction of the line in the amount of \$71,000. He then presented the request of Western Water for the release of four parcels for service by them that are located along their portion of the water line project. Upon discussion, the Board resolved (Resolution 17-0695) to release to Western Water Company four parcels along Brimstone Road and State Route 73 in Massie Township and the Village of Harveysburg for water service.
- 7. Mr. Brausch provided an update on the status of the request for proposals relative to a new billing system for the Water and Sewer Department.

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board entered into executive session at 10:07 a.m. to discus personnel matters relative to specific personnel with OhioMeansJobs Warren County pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(1) and exited at 10:21 a.m.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
