DISCUSSIONS

On motion, upon unanimous call of the roll, the Board accepted and approved the consent agenda.

Tammy Whitaker, Benefits Manager, was present to discuss a situation where a COBRA participant was inadvertently allowed to remain on benefits longer than statutorily eligible.

Ms. Whitaker explained that the coverage should have ended in January 2021, but they continued to pay the premium and had claims paid from the coverage. She reviewed the overall premiums paid by the individual vs. the amount of the claims paid and informed the Board that the premiums outweigh the claims. She then reviewed the amount of premium paid vs. the claims paid during the ineligible period are deficient by \$1200.

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The Board stated their desire to forgive the \$1200 due to the overall net being in favor of the benefit plan. They then requested Ms. Whitaker to work with the Prosecutor's Office to ensure they can legally forgive the \$1200 but to immediately notify the participant that their COBRA coverage has been terminated effective October 1, 2021.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.
